Accommodation extends to 4 bedrooms plus a study, including a main suite with parents retreat, walk-in robe, built-in robes, and a luxe ensuite with frameless glass shower. Remaining bedrooms are fitted with BIRs and are serviced by a skylit bathroom featuring honeycomb tiling, a frameless glass niched shower, freestanding bath, and separate WC.

heating/cooling, an internal laundry, excellent storage, and a double carport with separate storeroom.
